

Directions to HSB building

Take I-5 to the Market Street exit and head west on Market until you get to Summer. Turn left on Summer (stay in the left lane while on Market and, eventually you will HAVE to turn left on Summer) and head south.

The yellow parking lot, directly across Summer street from – or west of – the Revenue building has a day-use area. You can purchase one-day parking passes from a kiosk in the parking lot. The cost is \$6.00. The kiosk will accept quarters, dollars or 5-dollar bills (change is given in quarters). There are approximately 85 day-use spots, which are almost always gone by 8:00 a.m. If you are planning on using one, you should arrive by 7:30 a.m. Then, park in an empty day-use spot (claim it!!) and purchase your pass AFTER parking. This way, you don't end up buying a pass and then finding out there are no spots available! If this happens, do NOT park in a non-day-use area as you WILL be ticketed! What are your alternatives if there are no spots? Read on.

The Capitol Mall Parking Structure takes up 2 full blocks in the middle of the Capitol mall and is accessed via Chemeketa Street. You can use the metered parking in this structure (there are meters for 2, 4 and 10 hour parking). "Plugging" is a "no-no". However, you can move your car from one corner of the structure to another without risking a ticket – you can't just move to a different meter in the same "block" (each corner is a different block). Or, just use the meters that you find in the adjacent blocks surrounding the mall. Be aware that there are not very many as most street parking is reserved for car poolers!

Another alternative – and probably the best – is to use the Park and Ride program. You simply park in the lot at the Salem Motor Pool, located at 1100 Airport Road. It's FREE. A Park and Ride Shuttle will bring you to the Capitol Mall and drop you off at one of 9 specific locations. It will also take you back to the Motor Pool. To find the Motor Pool, take the Highway 22 exit (whether coming from north or south – same difference). Then, turn right onto Airport Road and watch for the State Motor Pool sign – it'll be on the right side of the road. Shuttles run every 5-10 minutes, starting at 6:15 a.m. and running until 6:10 pm.
